## General Rules

1. For International events please see the documents as listed in Reference Documents Table.
2. Link to Rules for Artistic Skating Competitions - General (Official Requlation Artistic General 2024).
3. The draw for Cadet, Youth, Junior and Senior categories of Figures (group and starting foot) will be conducted on the Saturday before State training or as otherwise designated by the AATC.
4. One group of Figures (including the starting foot) for all other categories will be drawn and advised to the Chairman of AATC, Chairmen of Chapter Artistic Committees, the Chairman of CAOC and SA Inc office by email one month before the first day of the Australian Championship.
5. There will NOT be a separate figure draw for men and women.
6. If there are 2 or more panels of Figures, it may be necessary to move events to another panel during the competition to have all panels finish at approximately the same time.
7. Figures will be skated in the order listed in the requirements.
8. Individual skater events - National Events:
(a) Figure Events - Order of skating for male and female events will be drawn separately and skated/calculated as separate events.
(b) For events which are calculated using RollArt, male and female skaters will skate in separate events, however Compulsory Dance 1 will be skated by all of the men first, and then by all of the ladies. Compulsory Dance 2 will then be skated by all of the men, and then all of the ladies. Normal rotation of skaters will apply to the men's event and the ladies' event. The two events will be calculated separately. A draw for the skating order for men and ladies will be done separately. Free Dance will be skated by the men and then by the ladies.
9. Individual skater events - International Events:
(a) Male and female skaters will skate in separate events; they are never calculated together in the one event.
10. For all events which have two parts, the skating order for the second part will be the reverse order of the placement in the first part, for example:
(a) Long Program - reverse order of the placement after the short program;
(b) Free Dance - reverse order of the placement after Compulsory Dance or Style Dance, depending on the event.

There will be no redraw.
Please note the Masters and Advanced Masters Dance events are stand alone events and not linked one to another so there will be a separate draw for Compulsory Dance, Style Dance and Free Dance.
11. Skaters wishing to skate two events in the same discipline must do so in the same category eg Intermediate Solo Style Dance and Intermediate Solo Free Dance is allowed. Intermediate Solo Style Dance and Preliminary Solo Free Dance is not allowed. However, the same skater may skate in the same or a different category in another discipline eg Figures, Couples Dance, Free Skating etc.
12. For Pairs and Couples events other than Masters Couples Dance, Advanced Masters Couples Dance, Masters Couples Style Dance and Masters Couples Free Dance, the category will be determined by the age of the oldest partner.
13. Masters Couples Dance, Advanced Masters Couples Dance, Masters Couples Style Dance and Masters Couples Free Dance - both partners must be born in 1994 or before.
14. Dance Manuals:
(a) For all International category Couples Dance and Solo Dance events please refer to the World Skate Dance and Solo Dance Manual - Rules for Artistic Skating Competitions - Dance and Solo Dance Book (Official Regulation Artistic - Dance and Solo Dance 2024).
(b) For all National category Couples Dance and Solo Dance please refer to the 2024 Non-World Skate Dance Manual. This Manual is being finalised - a link will be provided when the manual is available.
(c) If the dance is not included in the 2024 Non-World Skate Dance Manual but is included in the World Skate Dance and Solo Dance Manual, only use the version in the World Skate Dance and Solo Dance Manual - Rules for Artistic Skating Competitions - Dance and Solo Dance Book (Official Regulation Artistic - Dance and Solo Dance 2024).
(d) If the dance is included in the both the World Skate Dance and Solo Dance Manual and the 2024 Non-World Skate Dance Manual please use the version in the 2024 Non-World Skate Dance Manual as this is the pattern and associated key points that will be used by the Technical Panel.

Reason: Some of the notes and key points in the 2024 Non-World Skate Dance Manual have been amended from those in the World Skate Dance and Solo Dance Manual for National category events.
15. The pattern dance section in Style Dance events must begin with the first step of the required dance section of the dance pattern placed to the left of the judges and finish with the first step of the following section or the next step of the dance required by the rules. A penalty of 1 point will be applied.
16. Vocal music is permitted for all events.
17. Free Skating, Dance, Solo Dance, Inline, Precision and Quartet - music with spoken words can only be used for a maximum of 10 seconds at the beginning or end of the program.
18. For all disciplines the time from the start of the music and the first movement of the skater, couple or group, cannot be more than 10 seconds, except Show and Quartet, where the maximum time is 15 seconds.
19. Precision and Show events will be judged from the long axis of the skating surface.
20. The AATC and CAOC reserve the right to modify International requirements for all disciplines, to be in line with any changes made to the requirements by World Skate Artistic Technical Commission at any time. Any changes will be notified to State Artistic Committees, Requirements Committee members, High Performance Coach and CAOC Panels as soon as possible after the change is made.
21. The AATC and CAOC will align all requirements for International categories of Figures, Free Skating, Free Skating Pairs, Inline Free Skating, Dance, Solo Dance, Precision, Show Groups and Quartets with World Skate ATC requirements for these events.
22. Skaters wishing to be considered for selection for Oceania Championships and Pacific Cup must refer to rules for Oceania selection in the current version of the AATC rules available from www.sk8info.org.au. Skaters wishing selection for Oceania Championship and Pacific Cup must compete at the Australian Championship in the event for which they wish to be considered. Any exemption to this will be on the approval of the AATC.
23. The current World Skate Artistic Technical Committee (World Skate ATC) manuals are available from the above web pages, and the World Skate web page worldskate.org/artistic/about/regulations.
24. The rule allowing an athlete (starting from 12 years old onwards) to register for World Championships remains unaltered. However, the athlete MUST BE 12 years of age or more PRIOR TO 1 January of the SKATING YEAR. A skater who does not meet the age
requirements listed in the Summary of International Quad Events or the Summary of International Inline Events for Junior or Senior categories must have approval from their State and the AATC to enter these events. For all other ages, refer to World Skate Rules for Artistic Skating Competitions - General (Official Regulation Artistic - General 2024).
25. All Cadet, and Youth athletes competing in World Skate international events MUST be at least 12 years of age on 1 January of the competitive year.
26. Masters skaters who are under the age of 50 years, and who have competed in any discipline at a Junior or Senior World Championship, must nominate in the Advanced Masters category if available in the discipline. Otherwise they may compete in the Masters category. Dispensation to compete in Masters category when an advanced masters' category is available may be given, on application to AATC, for reasons which compromise an athlete's ability to perform at Advanced Masters' level.
27. Mapping of Events

Every event created in RollArt must be mapped to a World Skate category. However this does not mean that the requirements for the event are the same as those in the World Skate event to which it is mapped. Please refer to the requirements set out in this document for all National stream events.
28. Music
(a) Certification MUST be on the World Skate Form - SD - Certificate of Authentication. The music certification must be legible and specific to the skater(s) and the event in question.
(b) Music MUST be certified by a person who is a qualified musician and/or a certified teacher of music. This means a recognised degree in music or a recognised qualification to teach music professionally and does not include dance teachers, unqualified people who teach music and/or play in a band or orchestra or sound engineers who do not have a qualification in music.
(c) Music must be submitted in MP3 format together with the SD - Certificate of Authentication and clearly labelled with the name of the skater and the event (see below). The exact time that the music for the pattern dance starts and stops must be noted on the Certificate.
(d) Music should be submitted for checking as soon as finalised and certified so that any issues can be resolved to avoid problems at the competition.
(e) Labelling of Music
(i) Music must be submitted on separate MP3 files for each skater and each event or part thereof labelled as follows:
Skater's Name_Skater's Last Name (and Partner's First Name_Last Name if Couples or Pairs) - Category (junior/senior) - Modality (free skating, pairs, dance) - short or long program, style dance or free dance or dance certificate or order of the elements. For Show and Precision, include the name of the group and the title of the show.
(f) Skaters should also have at the competition music in MP3 format on a USB as back up. This does not need to be submitted but must be available if needed.
29. Content Sheets
(a) Content Sheets must be created from the forms on World Skate website. A link will be provided when the 2024 World Skate Content Sheets are available.
(b) Content Sheets are required for:
(i) Couples Dance
A. Style Dance;
B. Free Dance;
(ii) Free Skating:
A. Short Program
B. Free Program
(iii) Pairs:
A. Short Program
B. Free Program
(iv) Precision
(v) Quartets
(vi) Solo Dance:
A. Style Dance
B. Free Dance
(c) The elements in Content Sheets must be in the correct skating order to avoid penalties.
(d) The timing on Content Sheets must be recorded in "m:ss" format with the time starting from the first movement of the skater.
(e) Free Skating Content Sheets:
(i) must show the time at which the Footwork Sequence (and Choreo Sequence for Inline) will start;
(ii) if a Lutz jump is included, it must be declared in the "Notes" section.
(f) Couples Dance Content Sheets - must record the start time for each element.
(g) Solo Dance Content Sheets - must record the start time for each element.
(h) Pairs Content Sheets:
(i) must show the time at which the Footwork sequence will start;
(ii) if a Lutz jump is included, it must be declared in the "Notes" section.
(i) Quartet Content Sheets - must record the start time for each element.
(j) Content Sheets from the World Skate website must be used - after entering the required details, click "Download as PDF" to create a pdf version of the document, and then re-name the document as per Item 29(k).
(k) Content Sheets are to be named Skater's First Name_Skater's Last Name (and Partner's First Name_Last Name if Couples or Pairs) - Category (junior/senior) Discipline (Couples Dance, Free Skating, Pairs, Precision or Solo Dance) - short or long program, style dance or free dance.
(I) Content Sheets can be amended if required. If prior to the start of the Championships, the amended Content Sheet is to be emailed as per the Championship Notice - add "Amended" and the date of the amendment to the name of the document. Otherwise, the coach must provide 4 printed copies of the Content Sheet to the Competition Director before the training session for the event (if possible) or at the beginning of the first session on the day of competition for the event.
30. Costume Requirements

Please refer to the World Skate General Requirements for Costume Requirements - Rules for Artistic Skating Competitions - General (Official Regulation Artistic - General 2024).
All World Skate rules apply to all National categories, except in relation to stops in Precision (see Page 43). Please refer to the World Skate Rule Books.
31. There are no proficiency test requirements for eligibility to compete at 2024 Australian Championships.

## Warm Up Times

For Free Skating, Pairs, Couples Dance, Solo Dance and Inline events, at the conclusion of the warm up period, the first skater will be allowed up to 1 minute before they have to take the floor. For exceptional situations regarding the number of participants and/or time limitations, the AATC or the Competition Director or Manager may decide not to apply this rule.

In compulsory Dance events, skaters will be allowed 5 minutes for a costume change between the first and second compulsory dances if required. The skaters requiring this time must provide this information when nominating.

## Figures

- Where there are less than 8 skaters in a Figure event containing a Loop Figure there will be a general 2 min warm up immediately before skating of the Loop figure, followed by a 2 min warm up for the first 4 skaters before competition for the Loop figure commences. The same procedure will be applied to any figure immediately following the Loop.


## Compulsory Dance (Couples and Solo)

- 10 seconds without music followed by 2 minutes of music.


## Style Dance (Couples and Solo)

- 4 minutes 30 seconds.


## Solo Free Dance

- Time shall be based on the routine time, excluding maximum time allowance, allotted to the individual routines PLUS 1 minute.


## Free Skating Singles, Pairs, and Couples Free Dance

- Time shall be based on the routine time, excluding maximum time allowance, allotted to the individual routines PLUS 2 minutes.


## Precision

- 60 seconds for positioning on floor.

## Show Groups

- 40 seconds for positioning on the floor for Large, Small, Junior and Open Show Groups.

## Quartets

- 20 seconds positioning on the floor for all categories of Quartet.

## Couples Dance and Solo Dance - General Rules

- For International Couples Dance and International Solo Dance categories the pattern published by World Skate for the current year of competition MUST be used for compulsory dance.
- Dance Manuals for National categories - refer to General Rule 14.
- Tots wishing to compete in a World Skate event must have done both Free Dance and compulsories and must be able to do the World Skate footwork requirements.
- For compulsory dance a set pattern compulsory dance will be skated for 2 circuits of the skating surface.
- All compulsory dances will start to the left of the Judges as indicated in the manual.
- Opening for Compulsory Dances
- The number of beats of music to be used for the opening sequence of all compulsory dances must not exceed 24 . The timing will begin with the first movement of the skater/skaters.
- Entry and Exit Dance
- All dance requirements - skaters may use the competition floor during the exhibition of the scores of the previous athlete.
- Definition of Movement
- A movement is defined as any movement of the arm/head/leg/foot.
- Vocal Music
- Vocal music is permitted for all events including compulsory dance and compulsory solo dance.
- Special notes
- Style Dance, Free Dance, and Solo Free Dance can be started at any place on the floor.
- A SD - Certificate of Authentication of rhythms and tempo is required for the pattern dance segment of Style Dance. Refer to Item 28(c) under General Rules.
- $\quad$ Skaters wishing to skate two events in the same discipline must do so in the same category eg Intermediate Solo Style Dance and Intermediate Solo Free Dance is allowed. Intermediate Solo Style Dance and Preliminary Solo Free Dance is not allowed. However, the same skater may skate in the same or a different category in another discipline eg Figures, Couples Dance, Free Skating etc.

## General Notes - Free Skating

All rules for Free Skating apply as per World Skate Rules for Artistic Skating Competitions Free Skating (Official Regulation Artistic - Free 2024).

Broken Ankle spin is not recommended for Athletes under the age of 16, and is not permitted in any National grade, including Open Short Program.

Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events
For all National and International categories, if a position in a combination spin is mandatory, it must be attempted. If the mandatory position is not confirmed, the other confirmed positions in the combination spin will receive:

- $100 \%$ of their value for National categories; and
- $50 \%$ of their value for International categories.

Open Short is a stand alone event. Skaters can choose to skate just this event and no other Free Skating events if they wish.

Skaters who skate in an International Free Skating event which has both a short and long program cannot also do Open Short.

## Jump elements

- A Maximum of 12 jumps of 1 rotation are allowed including Waltz jump.

- The same jump cannot be presented more than 3 times.


## Spin elements

- Two spin elements must be performed. One of them MUST be a combination spin (maximum 4 positions). ONLY upright positions and sit positions are allowed. Biellmann positions are not allowed. The 2 spins must be different.


## Footwork sequence

- One footwork sequence, maximum Level 1.

The 5 steps and turns that will be counted toward the level are:

- Inside Three Turn,
- Outside Three Turn,
- Cross in front
- Open mohawk (forward to backward)
- Travelling (one clockwise and one anticlockwise allowed). Maximum 30 seconds

To achieve a Level 1,4 turns or steps, chosen by the skater from the 5 listed above, must be confirmed and each turn can only be counted twice. No feature is required for Level 1.

## Jump elements

- A maximum of 12 jumps of 1 rotation. Within the 12 jumps Waltz Jump, Axel, Double Toe Loop and Double Salchow are allowed.
- Maximum 2 jump combinations are allowed.
- The number of jumps within the combination cannot be more than 5 .
- It is mandatory to perform an Axel type jump that can be presented also in combination.
- Axel and doubles cannot be presented more than twice. If presented twice, 1 must be in combination.
- The same one rotation jump cannot be presented more than 3 times.
- In the program, there MUST be at least one Toe Loop element (single or double).


## Spin elements

- Two spin elements must be performed. One of them MUST be a combination spin and MUST include a sit spin (maximum 4 positions). Broken Ankle, Heel, and Inverted are NOT allowed. The two spins must be different.


## Footwork Sequence

One footwork sequence maximum Level 1, maximum 30 seconds.

The 4 steps and turns that will be counted towards the level include: Cross in front, Inside Three Turn, Outside Three Turn, Open Mohawk, traveling (one clockwise and one anticlockwise allowed), maximum 30 seconds.

## Juvenile Free Skating

3 minutes 15 seconds (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

## Jump elements

- A maximum of 10 jumps are allowed excluding the connecting 1 rotation jumps in the combinations. Double Axel and triples are not allowed.
- Maximum 2 jump combinations are allowed.
- The number of jumps within the combination cannot be more than 5. In calculating the value of the combination jumps, the connecting jumps will not be counted.
- It is mandatory to perform an Axel that can be presented also in combination.
- Axel, singles, and doubles cannot be presented more than twice as jumps with technical value. If presented twice, 1 must be in combination.


## Spin elements

- Minimum 2, maximum 3 spin elements are allowed. One of them MUST be a combination spin and must include a sit spin and 1 MUST be a solo spin. Combination spins have a maximum of 4 positions. The same kind of spin cannot be performed more than twice in the whole program (ie maximum 2 inverted, maximum 2 forward heel etc). Broken Ankle is not allowed and the 3 spins must be different.


## Footwork Sequence

- One footwork sequence maximum Level 3, maximum 30 seconds.


## Preliminary Free Skating

3 minutes 15 seconds (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

## Jump elements

- A maximum of 10 jumps are allowed excluding the connecting 1 rotation jumps in the combinations. Double Axel and triples are not allowed.
- Maximum 2 jump combinations are allowed.
- The number of jumps within the combination cannot be more than 5. In calculating the value of the combination jumps, the connecting jumps will not be counted.
- It is mandatory to perform an Axel that can be presented also in combination.
- Axel, singles, and doubles cannot be presented more than twice as jumps with technical value. If presented twice, 1 must be in combination.


## Spin elements

- Minimum 2, maximum 3 spin elements are allowed. One of them MUST be a combination spin and must include a sit spin and 1 MUST be a solo spin. Combination spins have a maximum of 4 positions. The same kind of spin cannot be performed more than twice in the whole program (ie maximum 2 inverted, maximum 2 forward heel etc). Broken Ankle is not allowed and the 3 spins must be different.


## Footwork Sequence

- One footwork sequence maximum Level 3, maximum 30 seconds.


## Intermediate Free Skating

4 minutes (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

## Jump elements

- A maximum of 8 jumps are allowed excluding the connecting 1 rotation jumps in the combinations. Double Axel and triples are not allowed.
- Maximum 2 jump combinations.
- The number of jumps within the combination cannot be more than 4. In calculating the value of the combination jumps, the connecting jumps will not be counted.
- It is mandatory to perform an Axel jump that can be presented also in combination.
- It is mandatory to perform a Loop, single or double, solo or in combination.
- Axel, singles and doubles cannot be presented more than twice as jumps with technical value. If presented twice, 1 must be in combination.
- The same 1 rotation jump as an item of technical value cannot be presented more than 3 times.


## Spin elements

- Minimum 2, maximum 3 spin elements are allowed:
- One of them MUST be a combination spin (maximum 4 positions) and must include a sit spin.
- One MUST be a solo spin.
- If 2 combos are presented, one of maximum 4 positions and one of maximum 3 positions. The spins must be different.


## All spins are permitted except Broken Ankle.

- It is mandatory to perform a Camel spin on any edge (solo or in combination).

- One footwork sequence, maximum level 3 , maximum 30 seconds.


## Advanced Free Skating

4 minutes (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

## Jump elements

- A maximum of 8 jumps are allowed excluding the connecting 1 rotation jumps in the combinations. Double Axel and triples are not allowed.
- Maximum 2 jump combinations.
- The number of jumps within the combination cannot be more than 4 . In calculating the value of the combination jumps, the connecting jumps will not be counted.
- It is mandatory to perform an Axel jump that can be presented also in combination.
- It is mandatory to perform a Loop, single or double, solo or in combination.
- Axel, singles and doubles cannot be presented more than twice as jumps with technical value. If presented twice, 1 must be in combination.
- The same 1 rotation jump as an item of technical value cannot be presented more than 3 times.


## Spin elements

- Minimum 2, maximum 3 spin elements are allowed:
- One of them MUST be a combination spin (maximum 4 positions) and must include a sit spin.
- One MUST be a solo spin.
- If 2 combos are presented, one of maximum 4 positions and one of maximum 3 positions. The spins must be different.

## Masters Free Skating

2 minutes 45 seconds (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

## Jump elements

- A maximum of 12 jumps of 1 rotation including Waltz Jump. Axel, Double Toe Loop and Double Salchow are allowed.
- Maximum 2 jump combinations are allowed.
- The number of jumps within the combination cannot be more than 5 .
- It is mandatory to perform an Axel type jump that can be presented also in combination.
- Axel and doubles cannot be presented more than twice. If presented twice, 1 must be in combination.
- The same 1 rotation jump as an item of technical value cannot be presented more than 3 times.
- In the program, there MUST be at least 1 Toe Loop element (single or double).


## Spin elements

- Two spin elements must be performed. One of them MUST be a combination spin (maximum 4 positions).
- Broken Ankle, Heel, and Inverted are NOT allowed.
- The 2 spins must be different.


## Footwork Sequence

- One footwork sequence maximum Level 1 , maximum 30 seconds.

The 7 steps and turns that will be counted toward the level are:

- Inside Three Turn,
- Outside Three Turn,
- Cross In Front
- Open Mohawk

- Choctaw (forward to backward)
- There is no limit to the number of features attempted, however no features are required to be confirmed to achieve Level 1.
- To achieve a Level 1, 4 turns or steps, chosen by the skater from the 7 listed above, must be confirmed and each type can only be counted twice.


## Open Short Free Skating

2 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 5 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events
In all the short programs the same jump can only be presented once with the exception of 1 jump of the skater's choice, which can be presented twice. Where a jump is presented twice, at least 1 must be in combo.

- Axel - single or double.
- Jump combination from 2 to 4 jumps including connecting jumps (1 rotation jumps). In calculating the value of the combination jumps, the connecting jumps will not be counted. No more than 3 triples and/or doubles allowed within the combination.
- Solo jump - single, double, triple (cannot be an Axel).
- One position spin.
- One combination spin. One of the positions must be a sit spin. Maximum 4 positions.
- One footwork sequence, maximum Level 3, maximum 30 seconds.

All spins are permitted except Broken Ankle.
This event can be entered by any skater who meets the age requirements. Skaters may choose to enter just Open Short if they wish.

Skaters who skate in an International Free Skating event which has both a short and long program cannot also do Open Short.

## Open Inline Free Skating

3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

## Jump elements

- Maximum 7 jumps excluding the connecting 1 rotation jumps in the combination.
- Maximum 2 combinations from 2 to 3 jumps, including the connecting jumps.
- $\quad$ The presence of a single Axel $(1 \mathrm{~A})$ is compulsory.
- Jumps of more than 2 rotations are not allowed.
- Axels, single, double or triple jumps cannot be presented more than twice as jumps with technical value. If presented twice, 1 must be in a combination. For a jump to be considered "equal" it must have the same nomenclature, ie the same entry and the same number of rotations. 1 T and 2 T are not the same.


## Spin elements

- Maximum 3 spins. Minimum 2 (at least one of each type):
- One solo spin (one position).
- One combo spin (maximum 4 positions).
- A position with the same base value (with the same foot and edge) cannot be presented more than twice.
- Remember: In a Combo Spin, minimum 2 rotations per position


## Footwork Sequence

- Maximum 1 footwork sequence. Maximum 30 seconds. Maximum Level 3.


## Choreographic Sequence

- Maximum 1 choreo sequence. Free pattern and maximum 30 seconds. It must include one "clear" and "visible" skating element (Ina Bauer, spread eagle, camel position, artistic upright position on one foot, etc).


## Masters Inline Free Skating

2 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

## Jump elements

- Maximum 6 jumps.
- Maximum 2 combinations of 2 jumps.
- The presence of an Axel type jump is compulsory.
- Only 1 rotation jumps, Waltz Jump and single Axel (1A), double Toe Loop (2T) and double Salchow (2S) are allowed, on their own or in combination.
- The same jump cannot be presented more than twice. If a jump is presented twice, at least 1 of them must be in a combination. For a jump to be considered "equal" it must have the same nomenclature, ie the same entry and the same number of rotations. 1T and 2T are not the same.


## Spin elements

- Maximum 2 spins. Only Upright, Sit or Camel are allowed. There must be 1 spin of each of the following types in the program:
- 1 solo spin.
- 1 combo spin (maximum 3 positions).

- Maximum 1 choreo sequence. Free pattern and maximum 30 seconds. It must include 1 "clear" and "visible" skating element (Ina Bauer, spread eagle, camel position, artistic upright position on one foot, etc).

- Inside three turn
- Outside three turn
- Cross in front

Each turn can be counted twice. No feature is required for Level 1.

2 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

- Maximum 2 side by side jumps (not in combo). Maximum Axel, Double Toe Loop, Double Salchow.
- One side by side solo or combo spin, selected from upright and sit (any edge). Maximum of 2 positions if combo spin.
- Maximum 1 throw jump: single rotation or Axel maximum.
- One contact spin: solo spin (one position) selected from upright, sit, hazel.
- One spiral, angel (camel) Backward Outside. Two handed support by the man allowed on Spiral. Two handed support by the man will be accepted if all other requirements are met to
achieve a level, however, the level called will be no higher than Level Base and the judges must give -3 QOE.
- One footwork sequence, maximum Level 1, maximum 30 seconds.
- $\quad$ The 7 steps and turns that will be counted towards the level are:

Inside three turn
Outside three turn
Cross in front
Open Mohawk
Travel
Forward to backward closed mohawk
Choctaw (forward to backward)
Each turn can be counted twice. No feature is required for Level 1
To achieve a Level 1, 4 turns or steps for each skater, chosen by the skaters from the 7 listed above, must be confirmed and each type can only be counted twice.

- LIFTS ABOVE HIP HEIGHT ARE NOT ALLOWED. It is encouraged that pairs include 1 hip height carry or rotational lift maximum of 2 rotations (eg bucket, loop, stag). This item will not be considered an item of technical value, rather a transitional element and can be considered positively in component scores by the judges.


## Juvenile Pairs

- One spiral, angel (camel) Backward Outside or death spiral Backward Outside. Two handed support by the man allowed on Death Spiral. Two handed support by the man will be accepted if all other requirements are met to achieve a level, however, the level called will be no higher than Level Base and the judges must give - 3 QOE.
- One footwork sequence, maximum Level 2, maximum 30 seconds.
- The lifts take-offs must be different.


## Preliminary Pairs

3 minutes 15 seconds (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

- Two 1 position lifts. Axel, Flip lift, around the back, low press, low Militano, low Kennedy etc. No overhead lifts allowed. No more than 4 rotations of the man.
- Maximum 2 side by side jumps with a maximum of 2 rotations (No Double Axel or triples allowed). One may be a combo of maximum 2 jumps.
- One side by side combination spin with a maximum of 2 positions, selected from upright and sit (any edge), camel Forward Outside and Back Outside.
- Maximum 2 throw jumps - Axel, Double Toe Loop, Double Salchow (must be different).
- One combination contact spin with a maximum of 2 positions - selected from upright, sit, hazel and camel in kilian, face to face, arabesque position.
- One spiral, angel camel Back Outside OR death spiral Back Outside.

## Intermediate Pairs

3 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 seconds)
Refer to General Rule 27 - Mapping of Events

- Two lifts (one can be a combo and one must be a solo lift). No overhead lifts allowed.

Selected from lifts like Axel, Flip, low press, low Militano, low Kennedy etc. No more than 4 rotations of the man.

- Each combination lift must not exceed 8 rotations of the man, with no more than 2 changes of position for the lady (3 positions), and single position lifts must not exceed 4 rotations.
- One side by side solo jump. No Double Axel or triples allowed.
- One combination of maximum 2 jumps. No Double Axel or triples allowed.
- One side by side combination spin with a maximum of 3 positions.
- Maximum 2 throw jumps with a maximum of 2 rotations (must be different jumps). No Double Axel allowed.

- One combination of maximum 2 jumps.
- $\quad$ One side by side combination spin of up to 3 positions.
- Maximum 2 throw jumps with maximum 2 rotations including Double Axel (must be different jumps).
- One twist jump with maximum 2 rotations.
- One combination contact spin (maximum 3 positions). Sit impossible and reverse layover camel are not allowed.
- $\quad$ One death spiral, free choice, maximum Level 3.
- One footwork sequence, maximum Level 4, maximum 40 seconds.
