## 2024 ADVANCED LEAGUE

## Open to all Queensland Clubs and other Invited Clubs

ALL RollArt events from the Advanced League will be held on the dates in the 2024 Skate Queensland Artistic Calendar set as International Advanced League or National Advanced League - RollArt events. Figure events using the White System (Sk8Calc) will be held on the dates specified as All Leagues Figure and Beginner Events. Please see Appendix C for a list of events for each type of league.

The Advanced League RollArt events will be split into National and International sections and will be held over 2 different Sundays. RollArt events listed in the 2024 World Skate Requirements will be held on one Sunday and the RollArt events listed in the National sections of the 2024 Australian Championships Requirements will be held on another Sunday.

## Eligibility

Skaters who have competed in this league in the last two years and/or State and/or Australian Championship in the discipline in which they are nominating and/or skaters who are eligible for, and wish to compete, in the 2024 State Championships.

Skaters who have competed in the Elementary or Secondary League in the same discipline and equivalent category may also move to the Advanced League.

This league is not intended for beginners or skaters who have not competed previously. Any skater who competes in any beginner event in the Elementary League is NOT permitted to skate in any event (including precision, show or quartet) in this league.

## Initial Registration Fees

Club Registration Fee*:

* Only one initial registration fee is payable for International Advanced League and National Advanced League. Please do not make two payments for club registration for Advanced League.


## Skaters Entry Fee per Round

Skaters Registration Fee*:
\$21.45 (all events)
Skaters Nomination Fee (National - one part to event): $\$ 19.80$ per person per event Skaters Nomination Fee (International - one part to event): \$19.80 per person per event Skaters Nomination Fee (International - two parts to event):-\$31.35 per person per event

* Skaters participating in National or International Advanced League in Non RollArt and RollArt events in the Advanced League are only required to pay the Skater Registration fee once for each of the 3 rounds. So a skater who competes in figures at Round 1 of the Non RollArt League and another discipline/s at Round 1 of the RollArt Advanced League (either National and/or International) will only pay the registration fee once for all days of competition in each round. They will still be required to pay the event nomination fee for all events at each of the leagues. The registration fee is to be paid at the round of the league in which they first nominate (whether that is the All Leagues Figure and Beginner League or the National Advanced or International Advanced League).

Please note - Skaters in couples events will not have to pay an event nomination fee for their couples event/s.

## Precision Teams \& Show Group (including Quartets) Fees per Round

Skater Nomination Fee : \$19.80 per skater per event
Please Note: Skaters only competing in Quartet, Show Group and/or Precision pay only the $\$ 19.80$ event nomination fee and do not have to pay the Skater Registration Fee. Skaters competing in Quartet, Show Group and/or Precision as well as another event (e.g. Figures) must pay the Skater Registration fee together with the appropriate number of event nomination fees.

## Age Requirements

All categories and age requirements are as per the 2024 World Skate Requirements and the 2024 Australian Championship requirements.

NOTE: Skaters who wish to skate in a higher Age based category in this league must apply to QATC for permission to skate in the higher Age category. Where granted this permission will only apply to the Advanced League - Skaters will not be allowed to skate in a higher Age category at States or Nationals.

## Category Rules

Skaters can only nominate in one League per discipline (solo dance and couples dance will be considered as two disciplines).

Skaters can only nominate in ONE category per discipline. Skaters wishing to skate two events in the same discipline must do so in the same category e.g. Preliminary Solo Dance and Preliminary Solo Free Dance is allowed. Preliminary Solo Dance and Intermediate Solo Free

Dance is not allowed. However, the same skater may skate in the same or a different category in another discipline e.g. Figures, Couples Dance, Free Skating etc.

Couples Dance skaters can participate in Solo Dance and vice versa. Both couples dance skaters and solo dance skaters can participate in solo free dance where they are a separate event.

Masters couples or solo dance skaters can do either Style Dance or Free Dance - they can not do both style dance and free dance.

All dance and solo dance categories are open for quads or inline.
Skaters are permitted to compete in more than one precision, quartet or show team but it must be in a different category or league level i.e. you cannot skate in 2 different teams in the one event at a league.

Individual skaters in precision and quartet are permitted to move between league levels in those events, either backwards or forwards. However, precision and quartet teams that contain exactly the same skaters as the previous year are not permitted to move backwards from a higher level league to a lower level league.

FOR ALL DISCIPLINES. All ages of the skaters will be by year of birth. Please refer to the note in the Age Requirements section for possible exemptions to this. For Couples Dance, Style Dance, Free Dance or Free Skating Pairs teams the age is that of the oldest partner of the team. For Masters category team events all skaters must meet any age requirements. The year of birth for each category is detailed in Appendix A.

## Coaches and clubs must check where skaters are nominated - skaters should be able to at least do the requirements for the category.

International events with a short and long program will be classed as one event. Both programs must be skated to receive an award and/or points.

Skaters may nominate in a different category to the intended category at States - conditions permitting.

## Minimum Medal Test Requirements

There are no proficiency test requirements for eligibility to compete at 2024 Australian Championships or this league. However, skaters are strongly encouraged to participate in medal tests.

## Nominations

All skaters' must be competitive members of Skate Australia, and their registrations MUST be entered on the Skate Australia database by the closing date of nominations.

All nominations must be on the nomination forms provided. Closing date is 12 NOON of the Friday 4 weeks prior to competition day. No reminders will be sent regarding closing dates.

Nominations are to be placed into the correct folder in the club One Drive folder and an email sent to qartcom12@gmail.com to confirm that the information has been placed in One Drive. Clubs MUST get permission from QATC to make changes to the original document after the closing date and time for nominations. Any amended documents must include the date of the change in the file name.

Fees must be paid by club cheque or direct debit.

Please confirm payment (including receipt number where applicable) by email to gartcom12@gmail.com (using the Confirmation of Payment to Skate Queensland Artistic Form). This applies whether payment is made by direct debit or cheque. The document should also be placed in One Drive in the Confirmation of Payments folder. The amount paid should match the amount on the nomination forms (or other amount where QATC has advised differently).

CLUBS WHOSE NOMINATIONS ARE RECEIVED LATE (i.e. after the closing date) WILL RECEIVE NO POINTS FOR THE ROUND IN WHICH THEY NOMINATE LATE AND MAY INCUR A LATE FEE OF \$22.00.

## NO FUTURE NOMINATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM CLUBS WHEN THERE ARE MONIES OUTSTANDING FROM ANY PREVIOUS COMPETITION/TEST UNTIL SUCH OUTSTANDING PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE. CLUBS WHO DO NOT PAY WITHIN 4 BUSINESS DAYS MAY HAVE THEIR SKATERS WITHDRAWN FROM THE COMPETITION.

## Awards and Allocation of Points

Medals shall be awarded to individual place getters in each category in each round of the League.

Ties in events will be resolved using the Tie Break Rules in the World Skate General 2024 Official Regulation Artistic manual (Section 4, Placements). NOTE: This includes ties after the first part of the event to determine skating order for the second part of the event for international 2 part events.

Overall trophies shall be presented to the skaters and couples dance/pairs teams with the most points for $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ calculated from the three rounds. Points are awarded as follows:

- First Place $=8$ points
- Second Place = 4 points
- Third Place $=2$ points

Skaters must skate the three rounds in the same category and when applicable, with the same partner to be eligible for an overall trophy. In addition, skaters must have placed in at least one round of any of the 3 rounds of the league in order to be eligible to receive an individual overall trophy (i.e. a skater with 0 points from the 3 rounds of the league will not receive a trophy). Where the skaters are tied after 3 rounds of the league then the skater that placed the highest in the third round will be given the higher place trophy. If they are still tied then the skater with the highest technical score on the day will be given the higher place trophy.

Couples Dance, Style Dance, Free Dance and Free Skating Pairs may also be from different clubs and each skater (club for overall) will receive 50 percent of the points earned by that team for the event.

Precision/Quartet/Show teams may be made up of skaters from different clubs. No club points will be awarded for these events.

Overall trophies shall be awarded to clubs placing $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ over all disciplines except Precision, Show and Quartet events (which may have skaters from different clubs in the one team). This trophy will not be awarded until the final round of the Advanced League has been completed (all 3 rounds of the All Leagues Figure and Beginner Events, International and National Advanced Leagues must have been held). Clubs are not required to participate in all three rounds to be eligible for the overall trophies but must have earned points (i.e. a club with 0 points from participation in the Advanced League will not receive a trophy).

Overall trophies shall be awarded to Precision, Show and Quartet teams that have participated in all three rounds in the same category for the teams that place $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ (calculated from the three rounds). Points allocated as above.

All awards (medals and trophies) must be collected on the day of competition - if not collected by the skater or an adult club representative the award will be forfeited.

## Presentations

All skaters must be neatly attired or in competition outfit wearing shoes or skates for presentations. Skaters with bare feet will not be able to collect their medal at the time of presentation or later.

## Withdrawals

All withdrawals must be in writing and signed by a club representative. Withdrawals must be given to the League Director or the appointed receiver as soon as possible. There are no
refunds. A credit may be given if a medical certificate (dated prior to or within 2 days after the day of the event) is supplied within 2 weeks but only for another event within that same skating year.

PLEASE NOTE: Any credit for roll over of fees is for that skater only. It is NOT a credit for the club.

## Marshalling area

All competitors should be in the building at the start of the competition as the order of events is subject to change. Skaters are not permitted to go onto the skating surface for warm up unless they have marshalled in.

Parents or coaches cannot marshal in for the skaters. All competitors must be in the marshalling area one event (or at least 15 minutes prior to the start of their event if events are small). The competitor must remain in the marshalling area until they have finished competing. Competitors who leave the marshalling area before they have finished competing risk being disqualified.

Only marshals, officials, skaters and their accredited coaches in the current event and the next event will be permitted in the marshalling area.

Please note that at Mt Warren Sports Centre skaters should not be on skates in the warm up area more than 3 events before their event. Where the upcoming events are very small (i.e. no more than 3 skaters) then the skaters are permitted to be on skates in the warm up area 4 events prior to their event.

Coaches MUST hold a current valid Skate Australia Elite/Advanced Artistic roller skating coaching accreditation and a current blue card (which has been linked to Skate Queensland) to be permitted in the marshalling area. "Play by the Rules" (PBTR) modules and all required Sports Integrity Australia (SIA) modules must also have been completed for the coach to access the marshalling area. All required badges must show on the SIA certificate as per the latest SIA/PBTR requirements sent to clubs. The certificates must be uploaded to the Club One Drive by the date specified by QATC.

Intermediate, Development and student coaches are NOT permitted in the marshalling area for Advanced League events.

Coaches with skaters competing must also have their names listed on the club marshals, volunteers and coaches form for the competition if they wish to be in the marshalling area.

## Volunteers

The following applies for volunteers for each round of the league:

- Where clubs have less than 3 skaters in a league then they shall nominate one/two volunteers for each round of the league.
- Where clubs have 3 or more skaters in a league then they shall nominate two/three volunteers for each round of the league.

Times and availability should also be stated when nominating the volunteer. Events which are a conflict of interest should also be listed. It would be expected that each volunteer would be prepared to volunteer for up to three hours. The person nominated must report to the League Director when they arrive.

If a club does not nominate and provide volunteers for a League 10 points will be deducted from their overall club score for each round of the League that there are no appointed volunteers or if the appointed volunteers do not turn up and a replacement is not organised by the club. A fine of $\$ 22.00$ may also be incurred by a club that does not provide volunteers or if the appointed volunteers do not turn up and a replacement is not organised by the club. Clubs must inform the Event Director in writing of any changes in volunteers.

## Warm Ups

All warm ups shall be kept to a minimum. Free Skating Singles, Free Skating Pairs, Solo Free Dance, Solo Style Dance, Couples Style Dance and Couples Free Dance shall warm up for no more than the length of their routine. Solo Dance and Couples Dance skaters shall warm up for each compulsory dance for no longer than two minutes.

The maximum number of skaters warming up together shall be 8 single skaters or 5 couples/pairs. This may be adjusted at the discretion of the league director up to a maximum of 10 skaters depending on the event and age of the skaters warming up.

Precision teams shall have 60 seconds for positioning.
Quartet teams shall have a maximum of 20 seconds for entry onto the rink and positioning of objects or props.

Show groups shall have a maximum of 40 seconds for entry on to the rink and positioning of objects or props.

There is no separate warm up for precision, show or quartet. A team member shall indicate to the announcer when the team is ready to start their routine.

For all disciplines the time from the start of the music and the first movement of the skater, couple or group, cannot be more than 10 seconds, except Show and Quartet, where the maximum time is 15 seconds.

## Music

All routine music for the Advanced League is to be placed in the appropriate club One Drive folder in MP3 format within 7 days of closure of nominations. Music MUST be submitted by the Artistic Representative of the Club or nominee club representative of which the skater is a member. This applies to all rounds. Music will NOT be accepted from any other person or club. Where music is submitted late, clubs may incur a fine of $\mathbf{\$ 2 2 . 0 0}$ per piece of music submitted late.

## MP3 files for individuals and couples/pairs are to be named as follows -

Skater's Name_Skater's Last Name (and Partner's First Name_Last Name if Couples or Pairs) - Category (junior/senior etc) - Modality (free skating, pairs, dance etc) - short or long program, style dance or free dance. For example: Ima_Skater - Espoir - Free Skating Short Program.mp3 or Ima_Skater - Preliminary - Solo Free Dance.mp3.

Naming for Show, Quartet and Precision is the name of the group and the title of the show.
More information regarding the correct naming of files is available in the attached Appendix B.
NOTE: Music files for competitions MUST be correctly named in the properties as well as in the file name - resubmission will be requested if not correctly named. If the corrected music is not received within 2 days of the request the music with incorrect properties will be corrected and a fee of $\$ 22$ per piece of music will be charged to the club.

Music will be downloaded from One Drive by QATC 2 weeks prior to the competition. Any changes to music following this date MUST be advised by email to gartcom12@gmail.com so that the correct music can be available for competition.

All coaches/skaters are to bring a back up MP3 file of the skater's music on a USB stick or portable hard drive with them to the competition. Music on a phone, iPod or similar device is not acceptable as leads are not always available to connect these devices to the computer or music system.

Music files are to be recorded so that there is a maximum variance of 6DB in volume throughout the tracks. Files that exceed this DB variance will be played at 85 DB for the maximum DB and will not be adjusted during the low DB level of the tracks.

All routine music is to be cut to the correct length for the routine. It is not acceptable to provide music that is too long and for the coach to expect that they can just indicate to the announcer that the music should be turned off when the skater has finished.

## Music Certification

Certification MUST be on the World Skate Form and is to be placed in the appropriate club One Drive folder within 7 days of closure of nominations (as per the music requirements). The music certification must be legible and specific to the skater(s) and the event in question.

The SD - Certificate of Authentication must be clearly labelled with the name of the skater and the event (see below). The exact time that the music for the pattern dance starts and stops MUST be noted on the Certificate.

Music Certifications are to be named Skater's First Name_Skater's Last Name (and Partner's First Name_Last Name if Couples or Pairs) - Category (junior/senior/advanced/masters etc) Discipline (Couples Dance or Solo Dance) - Style Dance - Certification

For full details required for certification please refer to the 2024 Australian Requirements and/or 2024 World Skate Requirements as appropriate.

## Content Sheets

Content sheets for Free Skating (both short and free programs where applicable), Free Skating Pairs (both short and free programs where applicable), Couples Free Dance, Couples Style Dance, Solo Style Dance, Solo Free Dance, Quartet and Precision (using the appropriate World Skate Content Sheet), must be placed in the appropriate club One Drive folder within 7 days of the closure of nominations (i.e. the same time as the music is required to be submitted).

Please make sure you read Section 29 of the General Rules in the 2024 Australian Requirements and include all required information from this section in the content sheet for the discipline for which the content sheet is being submitted. Failure to include times where required could result in the skater being disadvantaged or penalised. Refer to sections 29 (e), (f), (g), (h) and (i) of the 2024 Australian Requirements for times that must be included in the content sheet. Times must be in "m:ss" format. It is very important that the times entered are based on the first movement of the skater and not the start of the music as the timing for the program is started with the skater's first movement, not the start of the music.

For Free Skating please do not include levels of footwork being attempted or names of items (other than a Lutz) in the notes section (there is a space to put the time for the start of footwork sequences in the elements declared column) - the only information in the Notes should be where a skater is attempting a Lutz jump.

For Couples Dance Style Dance or Free Dance and Solo Style Dance or Solo Free Dance please do not include levels of footwork being attempted in the notes section - the notes section should be left blank.

The content sheet files MUST be named correctly as per below requirements:-
Content Sheets are to be named Skater's First Name_Skater's Last Name (and Partner's First Name_Last Name if Couples or Pairs) - Category (Junior/Senior/Minis etc) - Discipline (Couples Dance, Free Skating, Pairs, Solo Dance, Quartet or Precision) - Short or Long Program, Style Dance or Free Dance - Content Sheet. In addition, for all leagues please also include club name (initials used in programs is fine) and the date of submission (e.g. Ima_Skater - Espoir - Free Skating - Short Program - Content Sheet_GC_20-01-2024 (international category example) or Ima_Skater - Preliminary - Solo Free Dance - Content Sheet_PR_20-01-2024 (national category example)).

Incorrectly labelled content sheets may not be accepted. A fine of $\$ 22.00$ per content sheet may be incurred by a club that does not provide all content sheets named correctly by the required date.

Content sheet documents must contain ONLY ONE content sheet. If the skater has more than one content sheet to submit, please ensure that it is in a separate document. For example, Free Skating short program content sheets must be a separate document from the long program content sheet. Please remove the instruction page from any content sheet prior to submission (only the actual content sheet itself is to be saved in One Drive).

## If a content sheet is amended after the closing date for submission:

The Club MUST advise QATC of any changes made to the original document uploaded to One Drive - Note: any amended content sheet MUST be in One Drive no later than the Wednesday before the league. Please add the word amended and date of amendment to the file name of the updated document. e.g. Ima_Skater - Youth - Free Skating - Short Program - Content Sheet_Amended_PR_20-01-2024.
The club MAY also choose to provide 3 printed copies of the updated content sheet to the competition director (or delegate) at the start of the competition day. The printed content sheets will need to have the skater number, event number and name at the top of the actual sheet (e.g. Event 1 Skater 1 Ima Skater). Note: Where the content list is for the second part of an international event then please just use Skater 0 as the actual skater number won't be known until after the first section is completed. This MUST be done if the content sheet has been changed within 3 days before the competition as the content list in one drive on the Wednesday prior to the event will be the version that has been printed for the technical panel.

Please Note: These requirements differ slightly to the details required for Content Sheets in section 25 of the 2024 Australian Requirements document as the club and date of submission have been added for leagues in Queensland as well as additional information if submitting a late change to a content sheet.

## General Rules

All figures shall be skated two rounds only, except for loops which shall be skated three rounds.
All compulsory dances and solo dances must be skated in accordance with the current World Skate Dance Book or the Australian Artistic Technical Committee 2024 Non-World Skate Dance Manual (whichever is applicable according to the requirements). Please refer to Section 14 in the General Rules of the 2024 Australian Requirements. All compulsory dances start to the left of the judges.

Freeskating, Dance, Solo Dance, Inline, Precision and Quartet - music with spoken words can only be used for a maximum of 10 seconds and the beginning or end of the program.

World Skate dress rules apply. The referee may apply a penalty of 1.0 for violation of the dress rules. Skaters may also be asked to leave the floor and may not return until the costume meets the dress rules.

ALL Jumps and Spins are strictly prohibited in the warm up area behind the blue curtain at Mt Warren Sports Centre. Excessive noise is not permitted. Figures are not permitted to be done behind the blue curtain - the only exception to this would be if a figure test was being held at the end of the league (the league director will advise when the skater/s may start warming up for the figure test).

## REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: If any requirements in this section differ from the requirements in the equivalent section of the 2024 World Skate Requirements or the latest 2024 Requirements Australian Championships then the requirements as per the World Skate or Australian Requirements apply (whichever is applicable to the category). Coaches MUST check the latest version of the World Skate or Australian requirements to ensure they are meeting the requirements of the category that the skaters are entering.

All Figures will be drawn from the groups listed in the 2024 Requirements Australian Championship (National Figures) and the 2024 World Skate Requirements (for relevant categories) at least 10 days prior to competition and advised to clubs by email at least one week prior to competition. Draw will be conducted as follows:

- All categories except Juvenile, Junior and Senior Figures
- The group will be drawn first
- Then 2 figures will be drawn from within that group (Loop figures will always be skated last). Please note that Promotional (National) and Tots (International) only have 2 figures so this step will be skipped for those categories
- Then the foot will be drawn
- Juvenile Figures
- The group will be drawn first
- Then 2 figures will be drawn from within that group (Loop figures will always be skated last). The rule for Juvenile Category Figures in the Australian Championships which requires that figure 14 is constant will NOT be followed for the draw at this league. IF Figure 14 has not been drawn for Round 1 or 2 of the league then it will be mandatory for Round 3.
- Then the foot will be drawn
- Junior and Senior Figures
- The group will be drawn
- Then the foot will be drawn (Junior and Senior will skate the full group of 3 figures)

If exactly the same group and figures are drawn for a second (or subsequent) round then the draw will be redone.

## FREE SKATING - NATIONAL

Times remain the same for all rounds. Items and restrictions as per the 2024 Australian Championships requirements.

Music files must be mp 3 files or they will not play on the system. Music that is sent back to a club must be returned to QATC within 2 days of notice of incorrect naming and/or format.
